Asset Lifecycle

- Business Needs Analysis
- Strategic Asset Management Plan
- Design
- Build
- Operate
- Maintain
- Modify
- Upgrade
- Dispose

Linear Assets - Examples

- Mains
 - Storm Water, Sanitary, Drinking Water
 - Reservoirs
- Power Distribution
 - Aerial, Buried, Transformers, Substations, Poles
- Roadways

Vertical Assets - Examples

- Pumps
- Motors
- Gearboxes
- Valves
- Motor Control Centers
- Air Compressors
- Valve Actuators
- HVAC Equipment

Asset Data

- Tools you'll need to collect the data. This is labor intensive
 - Pen, Pencil, Paper, Clipboard and a Warm Body
 - Access to the facility
 - With just those items you can begin your Journey for building your asset register
 - Desktop Computer with Microsoft Excel or Access Database
 - Below are Options / Modifiers to that Data (Nice to have stuff)
 - Laptop Computer or Tablet PC (nice to have but not necessary)
 - Can be used in-lieu of Pen and Paper
 - Digital Camera (nice to have but not necessary)

Asset Data

- Where to get the data
 - Location (where the physical asset sits)
 - Company, Facility, Building, Floor, Room
 - At the Asset (At a minimum collect the following)
 - Manufacturer
 - Vendor
 - Model
 - Serial Number
 - Equipment Description

Asset Data Continued


- From the Engineering Specification
 - Contract Information
 - Spec Section Number
- From the Engineering Drawings
 - Drawing Set information
 - Drawing Sheet number
 - P&ID data
 - Tag Number (Will become the Unique Asset Number)

Asset Data Continued

- Examples of what this all looks like
- Ammonia Metering Pump 3 what it looks like
- Hand Collected Data and Data Transcribed to Excel
- Finally what it all looks like put together in the CMMS
