

Difference Between Staff and Decision-Maker Roles and Responsibilities

















Decisions affecting longterm priorities such as mission, institutional direction, values, priorities, and principles.










Decisions affecting who are the organization's primary clientele, types of services, and the relationship of programs and departments to overall mission








Decisions affecting planning, budgeting, financing, marketing, and personnel. Budget approval process, setting rates and fees










Decisions about day to day practices, participation in community activities, selection of contractors, inter-local agreements










Decisions affecting procedures used to handle routine transactions and normal form, process, method, and application of policies









Decisions and regulations that guide or prescribe everyday conduct (parking, smoking areas, dress, etc.)











Compliance with Drinking Water Standards






Compliance with Drinking Water Standards






Water Quality and Fire Flow








Strategic Planning (Capital Planning)




